**Dresden** – Tradition and modern spirit are equal components of Dresden's cultural flair. There are also charming landscapes alongside the Elbe river with cast meadows, exclusive residential areas and magnificent castles. The great enthusiasm for the resurrected Church of our Lady is still unbowed. Another highlight was the reopening of the Historic Green Vault in 2006. This marks the return of the famous collection of the princes of Wettin, one of Europe's richest treasuries, to the Royal Palace of Dresden, its historical place of origin. Beer enthusiasts might want to try one of Dresden's old beer types at the Feldschlösschen Castle, e.g. 'Dresdner Felsenkeller'.

**Leipzig** – This city has been an important influence in European commercial and intellectual life for centuries. Johann Sebastian Bach was choirmaster in St. Thomas's Church, and many other composers spent time in Leipzig: Richard Wagner, Robert Schumann, Mendelssohn-Bartoldy, and the world famous St. Thomas Choir. Today many new artists live in Leipzig where a peaceful demonstration led to the reunification of Germany. Historical shopping arcades, lovingly restored, are typical in the city centre. There is a vibrant cultural scene and lively bars that stay open very late, all within a relatively small area. Leipzig's beer delicacy 'Gose', a top-fermented beer, can be enjoyed at the Bavarian Bahnhof pub in an early 19<sup>th</sup> century railway station.
