Visit also the medieval Old Palace - with its cloistered courtyard, the palace reflects the splendor of the former ducal town. Nowadays it is home to the Württemberg State Museum. Just a stone's throw away is the magnificent baroque building of the New Palace.

Freiburg – The minster is Freiburg's most famous landmark. Münsterplatz - minster square - is the focal point and the heart of the town. Freiburg's picturesque old quarter is grouped around Münsterplatz. The open streams - known as "*Bächle*" - which flow through the streets and lanes add to the charm. Also on Münsterplatz is the Historical Merchants' House, which was built as a customs house and warehouse. In the summer months, Freiburg hosts a local wine festival.
